ILC's occupational therapists can provide an assessment in your home to help you to determine the best equipment or home modification options for you. Following this we can prescribe equipment and support you to hire, trial and obtain equipment.

If changes to your home are required, such as a ramp or rail, or different access for a wheelchair or mobility device, we can help with this process too.

To give you confidence to use the equipment you choose, our therapists can assist you to set up your equipment and can train you in how to best use it.
