Comparing assistive technology (AT) - A tool to assist with self-advocacy and AT decision-making.

In her article 'Accessing AT from rural and remote areas', Nerine discusses comparing examples of rollators, and how that process assisted her in self-advocating and choosing AT that suits her best. The table below shows the criteria she considered when comparing the different models of rollators and which you could use when making a decision about your own piece of AT.
